Beaucoup is a concentrated multi-purpose germicide detergent for pre-cleaned hard surfaces in water up to 350 ppm hardness (calculated as CaCO₃). Effectiveness in hard water was demonstrated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test.

Beaucoup's powerful formula disinfects, cleans, and deodorizes in one labor-saving step in soft water. Beaucoup is effective against the following pathogenic organisms on inanimate hard surfaces:

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USES: Floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, restaurants, showers, conductive flooring, and lavatory fixtures.

For institutional use only such as for use in hospitals and nursing homes, schools and colleges, medical and clinical offices, veterinary clinics, and farms.

APPLICATION: Apply with mop, sponge, or cloth, as well as brushing, to thoroughly wet surfaces with the recommended use solution for at least ten minutes. The recommended use solution is used once and discarded. *for use as a holding solution on a daily basis*

For disinfecting and cleaning surfaces with moderate amounts of organic soil, remove gross dirt and heavy soil deposits before applying the use solution of 1 ounce of Beaucoup per gallon of soft water.

For disinfecting in the presence of hard water or for the treatment of instruments, remove heavy soils, and thoroughly clean the surfaces before applying 1 ounce of Beaucoup per gallon of water with hardness up to 350 ppm (as CaCO₃). Tuberculocidal effectiveness is in ten minutes at 20°C.

For use in official establishments operating under the Federal Meat, Rabbit, Poultry, Shell Egg Grading and Egg Products Inspection Programs. Beaucoup is acceptable as a floor and wall cleaner for use in all departments. Not for use on food contact surfaces. Before using Beaucoup, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After use, all surfaces in the area must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Do not get in eyes or on skin. Causes skin and eye damage. Protect eyes with goggles or face shield and skin with rubber gloves when handling the concentrate. Harmful if swallowed. Cease use if irritation develops. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL: Consult federal, state, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as incinerated open burning.
