We strongly encourage the substitution of an alternate colorant for the List 1 Toxic Inert Ingredient Malachite Green. Any product which contains a List 1 Toxic Inert Ingredient in the product formulation must include the following statement as a footnote to the ingredients statement: This product contains the Toxic inert ingredient [name of ingredient]."

As per the telephone conversation with Daphne Waldo, which occurred on December 11, 1991, additional information is necessary to identify and evaluate the proposed colorant Carmoisine. The following information may be helpful to you in acquiring the necessary information. According to the C.I. number 14720, which was provided on the information sheet which was submitted to the Agency as cited above, the corresponding designation is D&C Red #10. An additional synonym may be Azo Rubine Extra. It appears that this dye is not acceptable for use in food for human consumption, as was indicated on the information sheet which was submitted as stated above. Forward to the Agency the CAS Registry number and an MSDS sheet to facilitate the review of the above-referenced colorant, and any information concerning composition from the supplier. They may send this information directly to the Agency, citing this product by name and registration number.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.

Loosen coils until ends move freely. Grasp each coil in the center between thumb and forefinger of each hand. Hold the two coils by gently pressing them apart. Hold one end and shake lightly or gently pry to separate the coils. coil stand into slot in comma shaped end of coil. Light of the coil and let burn (flame) approximate 1/4 inch out the flame and allow the coil to smolder until exposed shorter periods of use break the coil into desired length notched cut out of holder. For best results, do not use burns 6-8 hours in still air.
