d. The statement "Physical or Chemical Hazards" shall read as a heading, separate from the precautionary statements.

These data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

This will reduce the effectiveness of the spray. Place animal outdoors if possible to allow pests to escape.

Repeat treatment as often as needed.

Bedding:

For best over all results, spray animals bedding as part of treatment. All pest control products work best when the animal and its environment are clean and healthy.

Storage and disposal:

Storage: Store in cool dry place.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
