TO KILL FLEAS, TICKS AND LICE ON DOGS, CATS, AND PREMISES: (KEEP DILUTED SPRAY AWAY FROM LIGHT).

ON DOGS: DO NOT USE MORE THAN 1 FLUID OUNCE (2 Tbsp.) (30 ml) PER GALLON (3.79 L) ON PUPPIES.

For fleas and lice, dilute PY-RO Dip at the rate of 1 fluid ounce (2 Tbsp.) (30 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. [For young animals, use 1/2 fluid ounce (1 Tbsp.) (15 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water]. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge-on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not rinse.

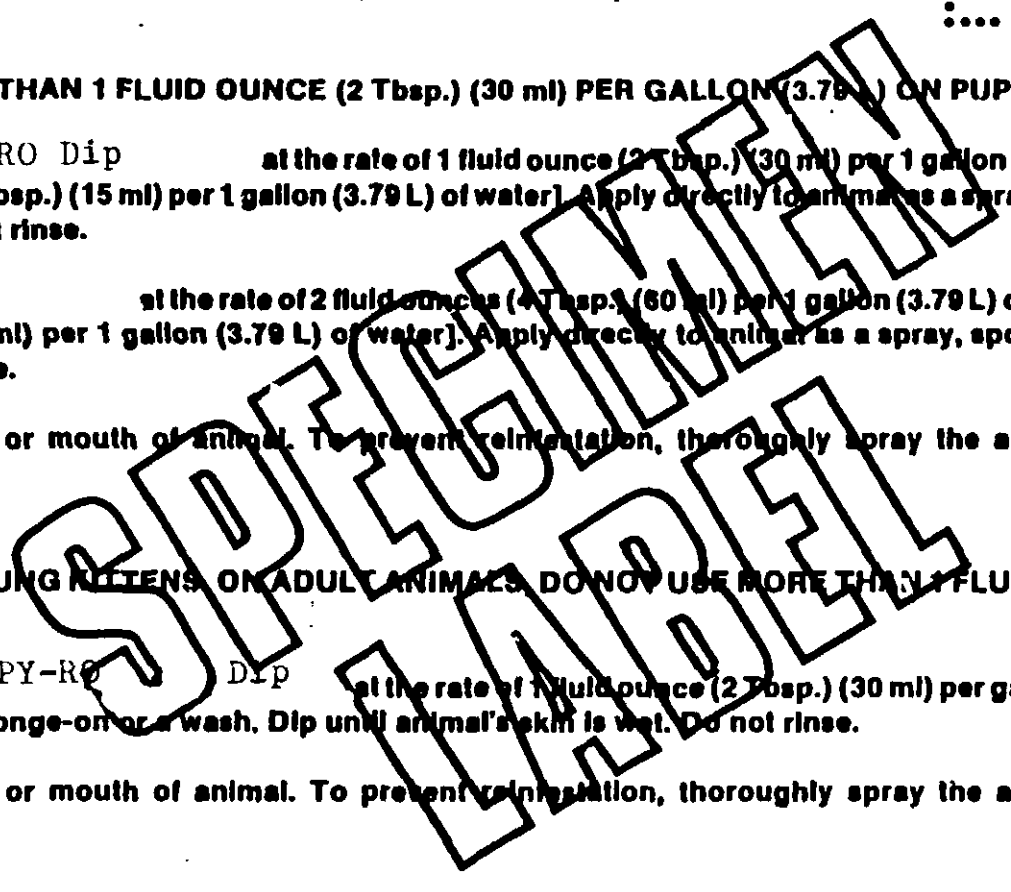
For ticks, dilute PY-RO Dip at the rate of 2 fluid ounces (4 Tbsp.) (60 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water. [For young animals, use 1 fluid ounce (2 Tbsp.) (30 ml) per 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water]. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge-on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not rinse.

Avoid contact with eyes, nose or mouth of animal. To prevent reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's living quarters with PY-RO Dip.

ON CATS: DO NOT USE ON YOUNG KITTENS. ON ADULT ANIMALS, DO NOT USE MORE THAN 1 FLUID OUNCE (2 Tbsp.) (30 ml) PER GALLON (3.79 L).

For fleas, ticks and lice, dilute PY-RO Dip at the rate of 1 fluid ounce (2 Tbsp.) (30 ml) per gallon (3.79 L) of water. Apply directly to animal as a spray, sponge-on or a wash. Dip until animal's skin is wet. Do not rinse.

Avoid contact with eyes, nose or mouth of animal. To prevent reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's living quarters with PY-RO Dip.
