This is in response to your label amendment to change the product name to "Pinetec Pine Oil" and to change the location of the net contents statement from the label to the container (with the provision that the net contents statement is represented on the draft label).

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

1. In the Physical or Chemical Hazards section, either add the word "heat" to the second sentence ("Keep away from..."), or replace that sentence with, "Do not use or store near heat or open flame."

2. Submit five copies of the finished labeling before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
