If swallowed, absorbed or inhaled by humans, domestic animals or pets, this material will reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such cases, treat as in bishydroxycoumarin overdoses, giving Vitamin K₁ intramuscularly or orally in mild cases or intravenously with blood transfusions in severe cases.

Repeat as necessary based on monitoring of prothrombin times.

POISON

Fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Exposure to this product during pregnancy should be avoided.

Repeated exposures to small amounts of this product can produce accumulative toxicity. Persons at risk should have their prothrombin times checked periodically.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN: Contains bromadiolone, an anticoagulant. For humans or dogs that have ingested this product, or have obvious poisoning symptoms (bleeding) or lowered prothrombin times, give Vitamin K_1 by intramuscular or oral administration. Check prothrombin time every 3 days or until values return to normal.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) required for this product:

- 1. coveralls worn over short-sleeve shirt or short pants,
- 2. chemical-resistant apron,
- 3. socks plus chemical-resistant shoe coverings or chemical-resistant footwear,
- 4. chemical-resistant gloves, and
- NIOSH-approved powered air-purifying respirator (PAPR) equipped with an organic-vapor-removing cartridge and a dust/mist prefilter.
- 6. If PAPR is not available then a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any R, P, or HE prefilter (if oil not present, an additional prefilter type, N, can be used).
- 7. Face-sealing goggles if PAPR is not used.

Note: It is recommended that you have your respirator fit tested.

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacoo or using the toilet.
