Foster 40-20 contains fungicides that will effectively prevent the growth and spread of molds and bacteria on its surface.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Surface Preparation: Apply only to clean dry surfaces free of all dirt, grease, mold or other contaminants. Follow the surface preparation directions on the product data sheet for the type of surface to be coated.

DO NOT THIN! Apply Foster 40-20 by brush or airless spray at a rate of approximately 1.25 gallons per 100 square feet. Always ensure adequate ventilation. Brushing will require two heavy coats applied at 90° to each other. Under normal circumstances a spray application can be completed in one coat, but for extremely porous or irregular surfaces, a second coat may be required. Insure that the finished surface is smooth and homogeneous. For airless spray application, use an electric 30:1 unit such as a Graco EH-433 with a .021 - .025 fluid tip and 800 - 900 psi atomizing pressure at the gun. Clean brushes and equipment with warm water before product dries. Refer to the product data sheet for more complete information on product use sites and application procedures.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE—Protect from freezing—product stability may be affected. Do not store or apply at temperatures over 100°F (38°C) or below 40°F (4.4°C). Keep container closed when not in use.

DISPOSAL—State or local hazardous waste regulations may apply if they are different from the federal regulations. Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
