- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 63836-2".
- b. Revise the precautionary statements to read:

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Do not get on skin, clothing, or in eyes. Prolong or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

- c. Change the heading "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" to "**FIRST AID**" and revise to first aid statement to read:

**"FIRST AID**

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF ON SKIN:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor.

The First Aid statements should be in a box including the following statements and information near the First Aid Statements described above:

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

4. You must provide the chemical identity of all components, Material Safety Data Sheets and CAS Registry Number for the inert ingredient Refas 65 (fire retardant). The supply may contact us directly referencing your EPA Registration No.

5. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) with the following revisions:

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EPA Reg. No. 63836-2

- a. In item 13a of the Basic and Alternate CSF, mixed units of measure were used. Only the same units of measure should be used in 13a e.g. lbs, kg, g etc.
- b. In item 7 of the CSF, the correct unit of measure should be used e.g. lb/gal or g/ml.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons.

Surface Preparation: Apply only to clean, dry surfaces free of all dirt, grease, mold or other contaminants. Follow the surface preparation directions on the product data sheet for the type of surface to be coated.

**DO NOT THIN!** Apply Foster® 40-30 by brush or airless spray at a rate of approximately .67 to 2.0 gallons per 100 square feet. Always ensure adequate ventilation. Brushing will require two heavy coats applied at 90° to each other. Under normal circumstances a spray application can be completed in one coat, but for extremely porous or irregular surfaces, a second coat may be required. Insure that the finished surface is smooth and homogeneous. For airless spray application, use an electric 10:1 minimum pump with a .021-.025 fluid tip and 700-900 psi atomizing pressure at the gun. Clean brushes and equipment with warm water before product dries. Refer to the product data sheet for more complete information on product use sites and application procedures.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE** - Protect from freezing - product stability may be affected. Do not store or apply at temperatures over 100°F (38°C) or below 40°F (4.4°C). Keep container closed when not in use.

**DISPOSAL** - State or local hazardous waste regulations may apply if they are different from the federal regulations. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
