It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

Used effectively at dosages recommended to achieve exposures to one part per million (ppm) of 'active' residual bromine to control algal, bacterial and fungal slime in industrial cooling towers, influent water systems, e.g. flow-through filters and lagoons, etc; heat exchange water systems; industrial water scrubbing systems; brewery and canning pasteurizers and industrial air-washing systems equipped with a mist eliminator.

Dosage rates

Initial dose: When noticeably fouled, add 2-6 lbs./10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat initial dosage until one ppm of 'active' residual bromine is established for at least 4 hours.

Subsequent dose: When microbial control is evident, add 1-3 lbs. / 10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat as needed to maintain one ppm of 'active' residual bromine for at least 4 hours.

ONCE-THROUGH INDUSTRIAL COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

Used for the control of algal, bacterial and fungal slime, by adding to the system inlet, or before any other contaminated area in the system. In once-through and closed-cycle fresh and sea water cooling systems; cooling ponds, canals, and lagoons.

Dosage rates

Initial dose: When noticeably fouled, add 2-6 lbs./10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat initial dosage until one ppm of 'active' residual bromine is established for at least 4 hours.

Subsequent dose: When microbial control is evident, add 1-3 lbs. / 10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat as needed to maintain one ppm of 'active' residual bromine for at least 4 hours.

ORNAMENTAL FOUNTAINS

Dosage Rates: See dosage rates for industrial recirculating cooling water systems.

AIR CONDITIONER CONDENSATE

Place tablet in condensate line dispenser. Check once every six months or as required. The life of the tablet will vary depending upon atmospheric conditions and indoor air temperature requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a dark, cool (below 86°F (30°C)), dry, well-ventilated area, in well-closed original containers, away from energy sources, combustible organic materials, oxidizers, strong bases and moisture.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or residue is a violation of Federal law. SPILLS

When handling or dealing with spills, use impact resistant goggles with side-shields, or face shield; body-covering clothes, including impervious rubber or plastic gloves and boots; use a dust respirator if dusting occurs. Sweep up dry spills and dispose of as described for pesticide disposal. If drum contents are contaminated or decomposing, do not reuse container. Isolate unneeded drum in the open or in a well-ventilated area; flood with large volumes of water if necessary.
