1. Change [subheading] "Storage" to read "Pesticide Storage:"

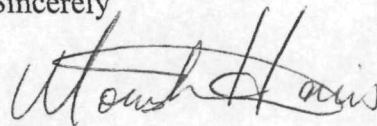

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

Used effectively at dosages recommended to achieve exposures to one part per million (ppm) of 'active' residual bromine to control algal, bacterial and fungal slimes in industrial cooling towers; influent water systems, e.g. flow-through filters and lagoons, etc; heat exchange water systems; industrial water scrubbing systems; brewery and canning pasteurizers and industrial air-washing systems equipped with a mist eliminator.

Dosage rates

Initial dose: When noticeably fouled, add 2-6 lbs./10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat initial dosage until one ppm of 'active' residual bromine is established for at least 4 hours.
Subsequent dose: When microbial control is evident, add 1-3 lbs./10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat as needed to maintain one ppm of 'active' residual bromine for 4 hours.

ORNAMENTAL FOUNTAINS

Dosage Rates: See dosage rates for industrial recirculating cooling water systems.

AIR CONDITIONER CONDENSATE

Place tablet in condensate line dispenser. Check once every six months or as required. The life of the tablet will vary depending upon atmospheric conditions and indoor air temperature requirements.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE

Store in a dark, cool (below 86°F (30°C)), dry, well-ventilated area, in well-closed original containers, away from energy sources, combustible organic materials, oxidizers, strong bases and moisture.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Nonrefillable container. Do not use this container to hold materials other than pesticides or dilute pesticides (rinsate). After emptying and cleaning, it may be allowable to temporarily hold rinsate or other pesticide-related materials in the container. Contact your state regulatory agency to determine allowable practices in your state. Clean container promptly after emptying. Offer for recycling if available. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

SPILLS

When handling or dealing with spills, use impact resistant goggles with side-shields, or face shield; body-covering clothes, including impervious rubber or plastic gloves and boots; use a dust respirator if dusting occurs. Sweep up dry spills and dispose of as described for pesticide disposal. If drum contents are contaminated or decomposing, do not reseal container. Isolate unsealed drum in the open or in a well-ventilated area; flood with large volumes of water if necessary.

IN CASE OF FIRE

Do not use ammonium phosphate extinguisher near water and BCDMH TABS. Hazardous reactions may occur.
