
- B. Under the **“Ingredients Statement”** on the product label, identify the weight percentage of **“Other ingredients”** as **“99.128%.”**
- C. Add the heading **“Physical or Chemical Hazards”** immediately above the following instructions: Avoid chlorine and strong reducing agents when using or storing this product.
- D. Under the new **“Pesticide or Chemical Hazards”** section of the product label, place a statement regarding the incompatibility of the product with alcohols, aldehydes, thiols, and ammonia-containing products, as evidenced by the applicant’s response to OPPTS 830.6314 (Oxidation; Reduction; Chemical Incompatibility) requirements.
- E. Under the **“Storage”** sections on the product label, add instructions that specify what to do if the product leaks or spills from the product container.
- F. Under the **“ Use Direction”** section **“All 30 seconds contact time”** Must replace with **“at least one minute (60 seconds) contact time”**
