

The pocket sized disinfectant spray for use on toilet seats, telephones, door knobs and similar hard non-porous, inanimate, environmental surfaces, in homes, restaurants, hotels, motels, and gas stations.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To clean, deodorize, and kill herpes simplex type 1 and 2, hold dispenser 18 inches from the surface, press atomizer with quick short strokes, spraying evenly and wet. Wait 30 seconds and wipe dry with tissue. To kill mold, spray and keep exposed as above, wait 10 minutes and wipe dry.

Reduce the danger of infection from the inanimate environment, with the pocket sized disinfectant spray, for use on toilet seats, telephones, door knobs and similar hard non-porous inanimate environmental surfaces.

Sprayed on environmental surfaces, kills (HIV-1) (Aids Virus), human immunodeficiency virus Type 1, Herpes Simplex Type 1 and Type 2, Papain, *Herpes I*, and *Pseudomonas* in 30 seconds. Kills Influenza, A-2 (Asian) and *Salmonella*, *Staph*, *Legionella pneumophila*, *Strep*, *Treponema pallidum* Pathogenic Fungi; (Athlete's Foot, and Ringworm - *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*) *Aspergillus niger* in 10 minutes.

KILLS HIV-1 ON ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS:

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Specific barrier protection items to be used when handling items soiled with blood or body fluids are disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks, or eye coverings.

CLEANING PROCEDURE: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of the disinfectant.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

CONTACT TIME: Leave surfaces wet for 30 seconds. This contact time will not control other common types of viruses and bacteria.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage disposal.

Do not reuse empty container (bottle, can, bucket). Wrap container and put in trash.
