"To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Chontrol Paste is a biological herbicide for control of sprouting or regrowth of alders, aspens, buckthorn (common [or European] and glossy) and other hardwoods in rights-of-way and forests. Extensive field trials have demonstrated that Chontrol Paste effectively prevents sprouting of cut stumps by colonizing and decaying the stumps.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Chontrol Paste is a paste formulation in one-liter squeeze bottles. Each bottle contains a minimum 1.0 kg of product with a guaranteed minimum titer of 1×10^2 cfu per gram. One bottle of Chontrol Paste will treat approximately 200 cut stumps with a diameter of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch to 2 1/3 inch (2 to 6 cm) on the cut surface. Chontrol Paste is best suited for use on fresh cut stumps during summer or autumn. Apply the paste on the entire surface of the cut area. Entire contents in the bottle must be used on the same day after opening. Use before the expiration date on the unopened package. Do not mix Chontrol Paste with chemical pesticides or herbicides.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store under refrigeration temperatures [38°-46°F (4°-8°C)]. Entire contents in the bottle must be used on the same day after opening. Use before the expiration date on the unopened package.

Pesticide Disposal: To avoid waste, use all material in the container by application according to label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to a waste disposal facility or pesticide disposal program (as run by state or local government or by industry).
