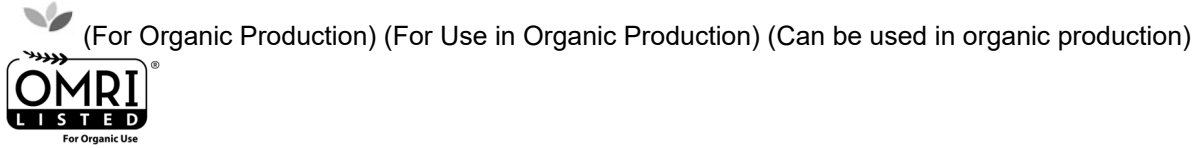

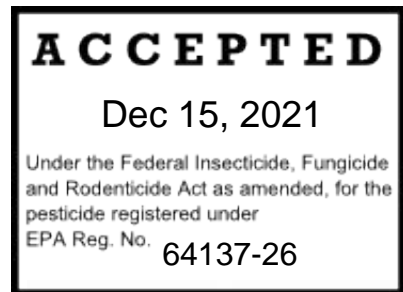

PRODUCT INFORMATION

LALFRESH S is for post-harvest treatment of the **Stone Fruit crop group**, including plums, peaches, and nectarines, to control storage diseases caused by *Monilinia* spp.

USE INSTRUCTIONS

Apply LALFRESH S by spraying harvested fruit at the sorting table/packaging line. Product can only be applied to whole fruits. Apply over conveyor belt or rollers, soft clean brushes or donut rolls by drip or spray to fruit prior to storage. As sometimes fruit is wet or damp before harvest, apply LALFRESH S at a rate of 16 oz (454 g) diluted in enough water to cover 110,000 lbs (50,000 kg) fruit. (Approximately, 40 gal (150 L) of water.) Agitate carefully until the suspension is homogeneous. To ensure maximum efficacy, it is important that all fruits are completely and homogeneously covered by LALFRESH S spray solution. Use a sprayer system not exceeding 8 bars of pressure during spraying.

USE RESTRICTIONS

LALFRESH S is a biological control agent for post-harvest applications. Do not apply to cut fruits. Do not add directly to waxes, soaps, or sanitizers. Do not add to chlorinated water. Do not tank mix LALFRESH S with chemical fungicides, unless compatibility has been verified. Contact your Lallemand Plant Care technical advisor for more information.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place. Avoid overheating.
