DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DOSAGE: 1 tsp. treats approximately 600 gallons of water.

PROCEDURE: Mix dosage in container of clean water. If quantity of water being treated is less than that noted above, amount of mixture used should be in proportion to quantity of water being treated. Distribute mixture as evenly as possible over the water. Repeat dosage when algae reappears. One treatment normally lasts several weeks, depending on conditions causing algae. For **HEAVY ALGAE GROWTH** it may be necessary to repeat dosage within 8 days.
