TO KILL FLYING INSECTS:
Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, and Small Flying Mites: Spray directly on insects. For average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Before spraying, cover exposed food.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS:
Ants, Roaches, Crickets and Spiders: Contact spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of room. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden areas, and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever they hide. Treat doors, around window frames, pet trails and at baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet cages. **DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS.**

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and sunlight.
Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:
If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.
If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
If on skin or clothing: Remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If inhaled: Remove individual to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.
