#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.**

#### TO KILL FLYING INSECTS:

**Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats and Small Flying Moths:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

#### TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS:

**Ants, Roaches, Crickets and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

**Fleas and Ticks in Bedding and Pet Areas:** Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding, sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, local areas of floors, and other nesting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. **DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS.**

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### FIRST AID:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment. #### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

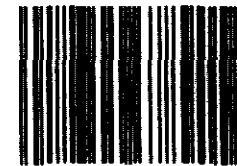
