DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SHARE WELL BEFORE USE

For Spot/Crack and Crevice Treatment Only. Do Not Use As a Space Spray.

General: Use this spray as a spot treatment to control ants, cockroaches, fleas, silverfish ticks, waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray in areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, PALMETTO BUGS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH AND SPIDERS: In areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closet crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails, around doors and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door localized areas of the floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
