- e. Delete all comparative claims , such as "kills ants faster," "faster acting."
- f. Claims that the product is "new" may be used up to 6 months from the date of registration.


40 CFR 157.32(a) child resistant packaging pesticides must meet the effectiveness specifications described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b) when tested by the protocol specified in 16 CFR The Agency has recently granted an exemption from the effectiveness specification as described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b)(2) ease of adult opening. The Agency will publish a Notice in the Federal Register of the granting of the exemption. This exemption applies only to prefilled, nonrefillable insecticide bait stations that are not designed or intended to be opened or activated in a manner that exposes the contents to human contact. This exemption is only from the adult effectiveness specifications as described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b)(2) ease of adult opening. exemption will be for a five year time period and will apply to other products of substantially similar composition and intended uses.

Any changes to the packaging or contents must be approved by the Agency prior to market introduction. Any alterations to the bait station and/or its contents will require submission and review of appropriate data by the Agency prior to any institution of the package change.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


