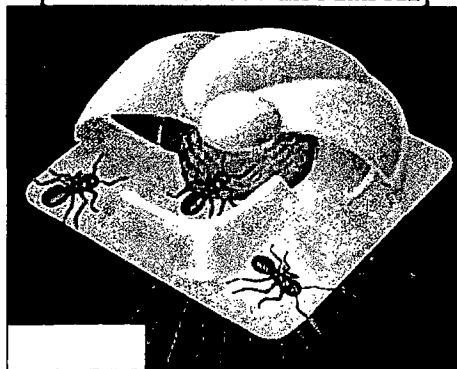

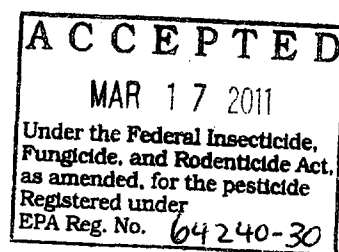

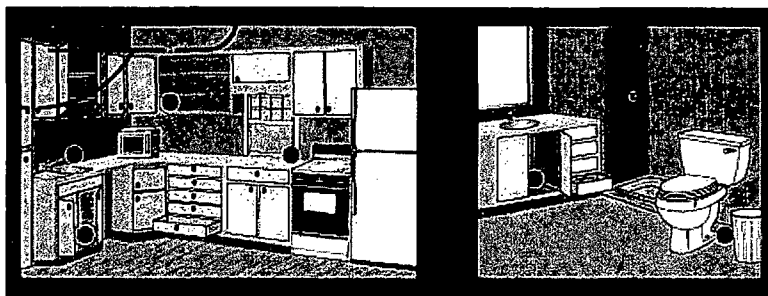

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use [all] [*package count*] [several] bait[s] [stations at the same time for thorough control]. [Large or heavily infested areas may require more bait stations.] Break bait[s] [station[s] apart [from plastic frame].
