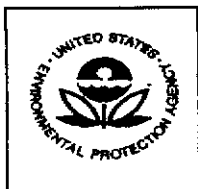

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 64240-34".

b. You must add Precautionary and First Aid Statements to the package label as follows:
Precautionary Statements
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION
Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling bait stations.

- c. You must modify the label as follows:
Delete the following marketing claims from the label:
Professionally tested for effectiveness.
All references to effectiveness/control/killing for three months
Prevent egg production or hatching
All claims referring to comfort, confidence, proud, relax, being satisfied, embarrassment, calm, regaining control of your home, secure. These are not pesticide claims.
- d. Delete all comparative claims, such as "kills roaches faster," "faster acting," "greater -or- better roach control".
- e. Delete the following claims which detract from label precautions:
Designed to use around food, children or kids and pets.
Designed with your child and pet in mind.
Ideal or trusted for use around food, children or kids and pets
Can be used around food, pets, and children
- f. Delete the claim referring to Asian roaches, which are not large roaches.
- g. Claims relating to "new", "Innovative" may be used up to 6 months from registration.
- h. In connection with the acceptable Child Resistant Packaging (CRP) study which you submitted or cited, the following specifications must appear on the package labeling.
Contains 8 child resistant bait stations
Total net weight 0.48 oz (14 g.) or 0.8 oz (22 g.)
Delete or justify the graphic "Institutional Size Economy Pack".
The directions for use must be revised to delete references to use of more than 8 bait stations.
- i. In the Directions for use, delete instructions referring to three months replacement of bait stations.
- j. The Storage and Disposal Instructions must be modified as follows:
Storage: Store in a cool dry area out of reach of children.
Disposal: Wrap bait stations in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
- k. The bait station label must be modified as follows:
Disposal: Wrap used bait station in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

The Net wt. must read 0.06 oz. (1.75 g) or 0.1 oz. (2.75 g).

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The statement "See outer carton for complete directions" must include the phrase "and additional precautionary statements."

3. Submit a revised child resistant packaging certification that specifies that the package does not comply with the senior and younger adult effectiveness specifications.

4. A number of marketing claims were found acceptable based on all of the efficacy data submitted to support the Combat Maxforce Roach baits. You must submit a revised data matrix for this registration which cites all of the roach efficacy data.

5. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

Under 40 CFR 157.32(a) child resistant packaging for pesticides must meet the effectiveness specifications described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b) when tested by the protocol specified in 16 CFR 1700.20. The Agency has recently granted an exemption from the adult effectiveness specification as described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b)(2) ease of adult opening. The Agency will publish a Notice in the Federal Register of the granting of the exemption. This exemption applies only to prefilled, nonrefillable insecticide bait stations that are not designed or intended to be opened or activated in a manner that exposes the contents to human contact. This exemption is only from the adult effectiveness specifications as described in 16 CFR 1700.15(b)(2) ease of adult opening. The exemption will be for a five year time period and will apply to other products of substantially similar composition and intended uses.

Any changes to the packaging or contents must be approved by the Agency prior to market introduction. Any alterations to the bait station and/or its contents will require submission and review of appropriate data by the Agency prior to any institution of the package change.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

1. Remove wrapper and separate bait stations from plastic frame. Do not remove or puncture the label on bait station.
2. Place baits wherever you see roaches. (Some of the most likely locations for roaches are shown in the diagram to the right.)
3. [For best results, use at least (8 -or- 10) bait stations at one time.] [Severe roach problems may require 16 (or more) bait stations.] [Roaches find the bait faster when more bait stations are placed out.]
4. Bait stations work best when touching walls or corners. Use enclosed adhesive squares when placing baits on walls or upside down.
5. Replace all bait stations every 3 months, or sooner if roaches return, (because roaches have probably eaten all of the bait.)

[Do not use sprays or loggers around bait stations; they can contaminate bait stations and reduce effectiveness.]
[Bait stations work best on horizontal surfaces touching corners and next to walls.] [Use enclosed stickers for vertical surfaces.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry area.

DISPOSAL: Wrap used bait stations and put in trash.

MOST LIKELY PLACES TO FIND ROACHES

[Place bait stations wherever you see roaches.] [Here are the areas where roaches are commonly found.] [Use (8 -or- 10) bait stations at one time.] Replace bait stations every 3 months.]
