

On behalf of Combat Insect Control Systems, I am submitting a notification for the product Combat ABF7 (EPA Reg. No. 64240-42). The purpose of this notification is to make minor revisions to the label. The revisions include addition of non-FIFRA language, clarifying which language is considered optional, moving the "Directions for Use" header to the appropriate section, and adding the following required language to the Precautionary statements - "before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet." Please note this language was inadvertently not included on previous EPA labels.
