• Delete all proposed alternate brand names from labeling, except "Combat Quick Kill Ant Gel Bait" and "Combat Platinum Brand Ant Gel Bait".



#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

This product provides FAST CONTROL of Ants in 3-5 days.

This product is formulated to effectively control Ants. That's because this product contains Fipronil, a fast-acting active ingredient. Its speed is still slow enough, however, for foraging ants to return to the colony and feed the bait to larvae and queen[s] so that the entire colony is killed through the Domino Effect<sup>TM</sup>.

[This is] How [This Product] [Combat®] [Quick Kill Ant Killing Gel Bait Station] (or Alternate Brand Name) Works:

1. Ants enter bait station and leave after [eating] [feeding on] bait inside.

This product will attract foraging [worker] ants to the bait feeding station. The ants will feed on the bait.

2. Ants carry bait back to colony so that it can kill the queen and other ants.

Worker ants will take some of the bait back to the nest where they pass it on to [kill] [destroy] the queen and entire colony.

Place bait stations near [an] ant trail[s] or where [you frequently see ants] [ants may enter your home]; near cracks, crevices, [and] along sill[.] [under and behind kitchen appliances, along baseboards, under sinks, in pantry, around pipes and water heater and in the garage and attic.] Use all bait stations.

[NOTE:] [Do not place bait stations in areas which have been recently sprayed with insecticide or contaminated with foggers, and do not spray insecticide over bait stations as this may cause the bait to become repellant.]

2. Place the bait station on a horizontal surface. While holding the bait station securely, activate the bait station by rotating [turning] the closure [1/4 -or-one quarter] [1/2 -or-one half] turn [counter-clockwise] [in the direction of the arrow] [to break the seal]. -or-

While holding the bait station securely, activate the bait station by rotating [turning] the closure [counter-clockwise] [in the direction of the arrow] until the [marks] [arrows] [indicators] line up[, indicating that the seal has been broken].

This opens the entrance holes in the bait station to allow ants access to the bait.

[In more open areas, inside cabinets, and near food, also use Combat Quick Kill Formula 3 baits for maximum ant control]

# For outdoor use (adjacent to the home):
