On behalf of Combat Insect Control Systems, I am submitting a notification for the product WC Complete (EPA Reg. No. 64240-65). The purpose of this notification is to revise the marketing language. Below I have listed the revisions to the label.

- 1. Revised claim #24 on page 5 by adding the optional word "Cleaner".
- 2. Revised claim #27 on page 5 by allowing the claim to be split with the intent that the language "Cleans & Disinfects All Bathroom Surfaces" is qualified with a double asterisk that specifies "Hard Non-Porous Surfaces."
- 3. Added the following marketing language on page 7 which is a reiteration of previously approved language: "Foam or Spray" "Foam (Closed Screen)" "Spray (Open Screen)".


