2. Submit an acceptable Primary Eye Irritation Study (Guideline 81-4) and Primary Dermal Irritation Study (Guideline 81-5) performed with the subject product's formulation. These studies must be submitted within nine months from the date of this registration notice. You committed to performing these studies in your FAX dated March 27, 1995. Your product's toxicity category may change based on the required studies. Other 25% permethrin products have been classified as Toxicity Category II for eye irritation.

3. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 64321-2".
- b. On the front panel add, "An Insecticide for Formulating Use Only."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ONLY FOR FORMULATION INTO INSECTICIDES for Domestic Indoor, Domestic Outdoor, Commercial/Industrial Use, Domestic Animal Livestock and Poultry Use for the end products formulated with the 25%.

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining an EPA registration for their products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
