Also kills boxelder bugs, carpet beetles, cigarette beetles, clover mites, confused flour beetles, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, fleas, head lice*, lesser grain borers, millipedes, red flour beetles, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, sowbugs, litter beetles (adults/immature stages such as Darkling, Hide, and Carrion), pillbugs, spiders (excluding black widow, hobo and sac spiders), spider mites (Two-spotted, Spruce), and ticks

Pantry Pests (Carpet Beetle, Cigarette beetle, Confused flour beetle, Lesser grain borer, Red flour beetle, Rice weevil, and Saw-toothed grain beetle): Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment to cupboards, shelving, and storage areas. Remove all utensils, uncovered foodstuffs (or any having original package opened), and shelf paper before making application. Allow treated surfaces to dry and cover shelves with clean paper before replacing utensils, foodstuff, or other items. then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use. .

House Flies, Mosquitoes: Apply as a residual surface spray directly to non-porous surfaces including walls, ceilings, window screens, and resting areas. May be used inside residential buildings, as well as in garages and storage sheds.

Pet Kennels & Bedding

Fleas & Ticks: NOT FOR USE ON PETS. Apply as a direct spray, contacting as many fleas and ticks as possible. Make interior and exterior perimeter applications in and around the pet housing structures. - 4) Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 5) Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level:
- 6) Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Do not apply when windspeed is greater than 15 mph.

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds. Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

Apply as a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the foundation and/or band area so that the insecticide will reach the soil or thatch level where pests may be active.

OUTDOOR ORNAMENTALS

webworms, flea beetles, forest tent caterpillars, gypsy moth larvae, Japanese beetles (adults), June beetles, lace bugs, leaf-feeding caterpillars, leafhoppers, leafminers (adults), leaf rollers, leaf skeletonizers, mealybugs, non-biting midges, Oleander moth larvae, pillbugs, pine sawflies, pine shoot beetles, pineneedle scales (crawlers), pinetip moths, plant bugs, potato beetles, root weevils, scale insects (crawlers), spittlebugs, striped beetles, striped oakworms, thrips, tip moths, Tussock moth larvae, webworms and whiteflies.

Apply at 4 to 8 weeks [1 to 2 months] intervals if retreatment is necessary with a lawn and garden sprayer as a residual surface treatment to kill the above listed pests.
