SOFTWOOD CUTTINGS and SUCCULENTS - Mix 1 part DIP 'N GROW to 20 parts water.

Dip basal end of cuttings only, individually or in bunches, for 3 to 5 seconds. Following dipping, immediately place cuttings into planting media.
