READY TO USE INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Shake well before applying.
2. Connect nozzle to your garden hose.
3. Push plunger at front of sprayer inward as far as possible forcing plunger past rib on sprayer body.
4. Rotate valve at rear of sprayer body to 'OPEN' position to allow spray.

If you care to use your own sprayer or sprinkling can, follow these instructions:

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Mix at a rate of one ounce of MOLE-MED per gallon of water. Use the dilution table at right to determine the amount of mixture for the area that you intend to treat. Shake well.
