On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an indorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 64492-1."
- b. In the "If Swallowed" instructions under "Practical Treatment," replace the word "glassful" with "large quantity of." Also, in the "If in contact with skin" instructions, expand the word "water" to read "soap and water."
- c. Revise the text under the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" heading to include the following statements:

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes

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skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Wear safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. For prolonged use, wear gloves.

3. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (a blank form is enclosed). In accordance with PR Notice 91-2, for the "Sodium Hypochlorite" entry, in column 14-a (Upper Limit), enter 6.6% or less (but greater than 5.25%). And in column 14-b (Lower Limit) enter 5.0% or greater (but less than 5.25%).

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
