

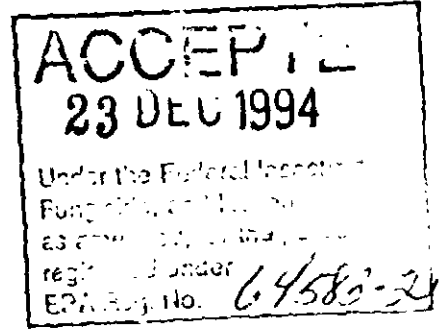

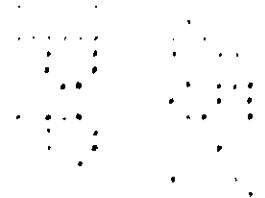

A new revolutionary kind of insect protection. Our "controlled release" technology provides 2-hour repellency with only 6.5% of the active repelling ingredient. And a sunblock ingredient protects from the harmful rays of the sun to help prevent skin damage.

INDICATIONS: For protection from mosquitoes, ticks (including ticks that may carry Lyme Disease), biting flies, chiggers, fleas, gnats, and no-see-ums. A single application provides effective repellency for two hours. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Filters out the sun's burning rays to prevent sunburn.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Do not use this product on individuals who exhibit skin irritation or topical allergies to soy products.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions before using this product. Adults should instruct and closely supervise children in the proper use of this product.

DOSAGE: Do not use on infants without first consulting a physician. Avoid over-exposure. Do not exceed recommended dose. Use just enough product to cover exposed skin. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Use the chart below as a guide to determine the proper amount to apply. Squeeze into one hand 3ml of product, an amount equal in area (length and width) to the (color) - shaded chart below. Rub hands together and apply thoroughly in a thin layer to exposed skin areas: neck, forearms, legs. To obtain the 6 ml dose, repeat the above procedure once.
