Subject: Revised Labeling and Confidential Statements of Formula
Skedaddle! Insect Protection for Children
EPA Registration Number 64583-2
Submissions Dated June 1, 1995, and July 14, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below:

1. The term "new" for this product must be eliminated. The Agency does not allow a reference to "new" on a product after one year of registration.
2. Add the statement "Wash treated clothing." to the Directions for Use section.
3. Provide a clarification regarding the removal of the Contraindications Statement.

The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated July 12, 1995) is not acceptable. The total weight of each component in the formulation sums to greater than 100 pounds, although the total weight box states otherwise.

The confidential statement of formula for the alternate formulation (dated May 19, 1995) is not acceptable for the reasons given below:

1. The total weight of each component in the formulation sums to greater than 100 pounds, although the total weight box states otherwise.
2. The nominal concentrations of the active ingredient and its isomers as reflected on the confidential statement of formula do not match the active ingredient statement on the accepted label.

3. The alternate formulation does not meet the criteria described at 40 CFR 152.43. Specifically, the alternate formulation does not have the same certified limits for the active ingredient and its isomers as the basic formulation.

The Agency does acknowledge, however, that upon correction of the above-stated deficiencies, this formulation will be designated as the alternate formulation. This correction was also noted in the Agency's letter dated December 23, 1994.
