- d. Modify the sentence about reacting to the product to read as follows:
If you suspect you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center.
 - e. Move the "If in eyes" statement to a section titled "Statement of Practical Treatment" (or "First Aid").
 - f. In the ingredient statement, align the percentages by the decimal point.
 - g. The term "new" may be used for only 6 months from the date of registration.
 - h. Please note that graphics or packaging which negate or contradict required safety statements are not acceptable. Pictures of children, illustrations such as toys, or packaging as toys which might be appealing to children are not acceptable.
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
4. Submit for the record a confidential statement of formula modified as follows:
- a. In column 15, enter the purpose in formulation for methyl paraben.
 - b. Enter the total weight in column 17.

If all of these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
