

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner that is inconsistent with its labeling. May be used in fresh or salt water, use on the bottom of vessels is recommended.

This paint is intended for use on commercial and recreational vessels.

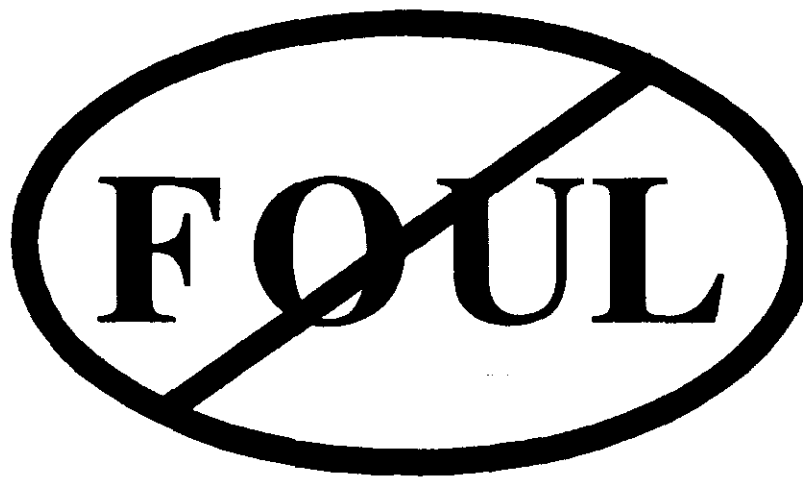
Directions for mixing: Mix contents of container. Stir until thoroughly mixed before using. Use immediately.

Preparation of Surface: The surface to be painted should be dry, clean and oil free. It should be properly prepared by solvent cleaning and/or sanding before any primers or paints are applied. Follow the recommended systems below. Bare metal surfaces should be primed prior to application. When sanding old antifouling paint, use a face mask to prevent inhalation of sanding dust.

Application and Temperature: *No Foul* can be applied by brush or roller. The work should be done under good drying conditions in the temperature range of 50 to 90°F. Three coats are recommended for best antifouling protection.

Thinner: Thinning not recommended. Clean up with EP-13.

Drying Times: Let the first coat dry for four hours before applying next coat. After application of the third coat allow at least 15 hours drying time before launching. Under adverse drying conditions allow paint to dry overnight to be sure that all of the solvent has evaporated.
