

- IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-mouth. Get medical attention.

3. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 64745-1".

5. Submit five copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
