
- 2. You must change the Signal Word from CAUTION to DANGER.
- 3. Add under Note to Physician:
Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
- 4. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

- 5. Submit five copies of final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

6. Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments". This action is taken under the authority of Section 4g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended.
