**SEED CROPS:** Sugarbeets, flowers, grasses, vegetable and legume crops grown for seed: Apply 10 to 40 lbs. per acre.

**VEGETABLES:** Asparagus, beans, beets, black-eyed peas, broccoli, brussel sprouts, cabbage, cantaloupe, carrots, cauliflower, celery, collards, corn, cowpeas, cucumbers, eggplants, endive, garlic, ginger, horseradish, kale, kohlrabi, leeks, legumes, lettuce, melons, mustard greens, okra, onions, parsnips, peas, peppers, pimientos, potatoes, pumpkins, radishes, rhubarb.

**rutabagas, salsify, shallots, spinach, squash, sweet potatoes, swiss chard, tomatoes, turnips, watermelons:** Apply 20 to 40 lbs. per acre.

**ARTICHOKES:** By air or ground application before tight bud stage: Apply 25 to 70 lbs. per acre. After tight bud stage, apply by ground application only.

**TREE CROPS:** Citrus: Apply 20 to 40 lbs. per acre to give even distribution. Avocado, cherries, peaches, apricots, apples, pears, bananas, papaya: Apply 20 to 40 lbs. per acre.

**SMALL FRUIT:** Blackberries, blueberries, boysenberries, caneberries, loganberries, raspberries, strawberries, grapes: Apply 10 to 40 lbs. per acre.

**TURF & ORNAMENTALS:** Ornamental greenhouses, ornamental planting, commercial ornamental

**DEADLINE BULLETS/MEAL** is specially formulated to attract and control snails and slugs. The meal is easy to use, clean to handle and economical. One pound will bait 1,250 sq. ft.

The presence of snails and slugs can be detected by their shiny mucous-like trail. They are night feeders and prefer damp, cool places in the ornamental garden, flowers, under boards or flower pots or piles of leaves and around fences, rocks, hedges and bushes.

Bait areas likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs. Treat every 3 to 4 weeks during the growing season, or as needed. During periods of high rainfall or frequent waterings, it may be necessary to treat more often.

If ground is dry, thoroughly water area to be treated. For best results, apply in the evening. Scatter the meal around flowers, ornamental plants and lawn areas. Do not place meal in piles. Apply one pound of meal to each 1,250 sq. ft. Apply only to the soil surface around plants. Do not apply directly to foliage or other plant parts. See below for directions for use around fruits, berries and vegetables. Always wear protective rubber gloves.

**FRUITS, BERRIES AND VEGETABLES:** To control snails and slugs around the following fruits, berries and vegetables, apply to the soil surface around the plants. Do not contaminate Consumer Use cont.

nurseries, ground covers: turfgrass areas and grasses grown for sod; dichondra; and around building foundations: Normally apply 1/2 to 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat treatment as necessary to maintain control.

For best results, apply in evening. Especially beneficial, if applied following rain or watering. Apply every 3 to 4 weeks during growing season, or as needed.

**NOTE:** When setting out transplants, sprinkle the meal around each plant after watering. These new soil, succulent plants are very tempting to foraging snails and slugs for the first few weeks after planting.

Deadline Granules Bait Tray Refill (Outer Box)

**NOTE:** Always open the Turtle, discard the used Bait Tray and install a new Deadline Granules Bait Tray out of doors away from living areas and clean up any bait residue.

Instructions for Replacing Used Deadline Granules Bait Trays

1. Remove the hitch pin from the fastener peg on the Turtle's tail and remove the Turtle shell.
2. Pick up the Turtle and hold it upside down over a paper bag or newspaper.
3. Push a nail, pencil or other pointed object through one of the small holes in the bottom of the Turtle and punch the seed tray out into the paper/bag. Fold up the paper/bag and discard it in the garbage.
4. If the Turtle is dirty, rinse it off with a garden hose.
5. Remove a new Deadline Granules Bait Tray from this box and insert it into the indented section in the Turtle base. Press the tray down until it snaps into place.
6. Remove (and dispose of) the Bait Tray's peel-back cover to expose the bait, then close the Turtle shell, insert the hitch pin, and redeploy the Turtle in your garden.
