Dear Mr. Hathorn,

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided that you comply with the following conditions.

1. Make the following changes to the proposed label.

a. In the second sentence in the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL" subsection of the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section, change "...in a sanitary landfill, or incineration..." to "...in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration...".

b. In the last sentence in the "Engineering Controls" section, change the sentence so that it begins with "Must".

c. In the second sentence in the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section, change "...cleaning of equipment or disposing of equipment washwater..." to "...cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwater...".


d. In the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section, change "...national Pollutants Discharge Elimination System..." to "...National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System...".

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration may be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
