### FOOD PROCESSING EQUIP

**To sanitize porous surface** etc.) Apply solution of 1 1/2 c available chlorine). Rinse with water. (100 ppm solutions may be used without rinsing.)

### PURGING COOLING WATER

- For removal of slime, dirt and other deposits.
1. Prepare EXPEL L-49 cleaner
  2. Add 4 oz. SANIT C-16 per 100 gal.
  3. Circulate 4 to 6 hours.
  4. Drain and flush system with water.

### STORAGE
