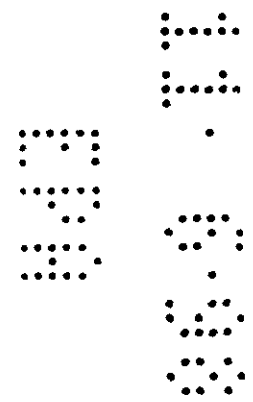

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is specially formulated to attract and control slugs and snails. The presence of slugs and snails can be detected by their slimy, mucous trails. They are night feeders and prefer damp, cool places. Apply this product in areas likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs and as needed during periods of damp weather. Treat every 3 to 4 weeks during the growing season or as needed. During periods of high rainfall or frequent waterings, it may be necessary to treat more often. If ground is dry, thoroughly water areas to be treated. For best results, apply in the

evening or at dusk, or immediately after rain. Do not place pellets in piles. Apply only to the soil surface around plants. Do not spray directly to plants. Do not mix with any liquid prior to application.  
**Flowers & Lawns:** Tip up spout and scatter Deadline RainTough pellets around flower beds and lawn edges. Apply any time, but preferably in early evening. Repeat applications as needed.  
**Vegetable Gardens:** Scatter Deadline RainTough pellets on soil around berry and vegetable plants.  
Deadline RainTough can be used on the following crops:  
**Ornamentals:** azalea, begonia, camelina, chrysanthemum, daffodil, hydrangea, geranium, honeysuckle, hydrangea, iris, pansy, petunia, rhododendron, rose, snapdragon, sweet pea, tulip.  
**Vegetables:** bean, beet, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, carrot, cauliflower, celery, corn, cucumber, garlic, horseradish, lettuce, melon, onion, pea, pepper, potato, radish, squash, Swiss chard, tomato.  
**Berries:** blackberry, blueberry, cane berry, strawberry.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Irritant if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. This pesticide may be fatal to children and dogs or other pets if eaten. Keep children and pets out of treated areas.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not refrigerate, freeze or heat by storage or disposal. Store product only in original container and keep it tightly closed. Keep away from children and pets. Do not store near food, feed, fertilizer, other pesticides or seeds. Store in a cool, dry place away from sunlight in original container.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Product—Partially filled container may be disposed of by carefully wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discarding in trash. Dispose of any piles or spills which may occur. Do not leave unused product of application sites. Container—Do not reuse container. Discard container in trash.
