This product is concentrated and should be diluted one (1) gallon SOPP Soap with nine (9) gallons of water to make a $2 \%$ sodium ortho-phenylphenate tetrahydrate treating solution. Apply as a spray, flood or dip with contact period of 30 to 60 seconds. Flush fruit with fresh water after treatment. Tolerance -10 ppm from postharvest application expressed as o-phenylphenol.
Pears: Postharvest control of bacterial and fungal decay rots. This product is concentrated and should be diluted one (1) gallon SOPP Soap with nine (9) gallons of water to make a $2 \%$ sodium ortho-phenylphenate tetrahydrate treating solution. Apply as a spray, flood or dip with contact period of 15 to 30 seconds. Flush fruit with fresh water after treatment.
Tolerance - 25 ppm from postharvest application expressed as o-phenylphenol.
*Not for use in California for control of Citrus Canker or on Pears.

## STORAGE \& DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water.
