

5. Update format of FIRST AID statements to that of PR Notice 2001-1 (see format below):

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

- Take off contaminated clothing
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice

IF INHALED:

- Move person to fresh air
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

6. Reformat the Personal Protective Equipment section to the following:

“Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Mixers, loaders, applicators and all other handlers must wear:

- Long sleeved shirt and long pants
- Socks and shoes
- Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material
- In addition to the requirements above, mixers and loaders must also wear a chemical resistant apron.”

7. Under a section called User Safety Requirements, add the following text:

“Follow manufacturer’s instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If there are not such instructions for washable PPE, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.”

8. Under a section called User Safety Recommendations, add the following text:

“Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.”

9. Change “Storage” to “Pesticide Storage” under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.

10. Add the following restriction to the label:


"When used in inhabited buildings (residences, offices, hospitals, etc.) windows must be open or an exhaust fan must be operating during the application."

11. Note that approval of the label should not be construed as a decision by the Agency that the warranty language is not misleading. This label language may eventually have to be changed because of over broad statements, or language that negates or detracts from required label statements.

12. You will submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).

A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

RAZOROOTER PRODUCT INFORMATION

RAZOROOTER is a dichlobenil wettable powder, that is designed to control tree roots in sewers, and to provide residual control of root growths. RAZOROOTER may be used alone or in combination with other products registered by EPA for use in sewers. RAZOROOTER is designed for use in sanitary and storm sewers. RAZOROOTER may be spray painted on, applied as a full volume foam, or a spray foam.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner that is inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT USE PRECAUTIONS

Always use caution to assure that foam and/or spray does not enter buildings. Do not exceed recommended dosage rates.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Mix 1 to 2 lbs. of RAZOROOTER with 75 to 100 gallons of water.

BEFORE MIXING: Read label instructions and follow all precautionary statements. Assess field conditions, and mix only the amount that is required for one days operation, or less.

Foaming agents and/or other surfactants and adjuvants may be added to improve efficacy.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All application methods for main line sewers involves the delivery of a discharge hose through the entire sewer to be treated. The product is generally applied as the hose is retrieved. **FOR BEST RESULTS WITH ALL APPLICATION METHODS, APPLY THE PRODUCT EVENLY THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE PIPE SECTION.**

Apply 1 to 2 lbs. of RAZOROOTER in 75 to 100 gallons of water, per 1700 square feet of inside pipe surface area.

USE IN COMBINATION WITH OTHER PRODUCTS

The addition of other EPA registered sewer root control products may be useful in some circumstances. Mix additional EPA registered root control products in RAZOROOTER solution at concentration rates recommended on the product labels for such products. **WHEN USING ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS WITH RAZOROOTER, FOLLOW ALL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND LABEL INSTRUCTIONS ASSOCIATED WITH ALL PRODUCTS USED.**
