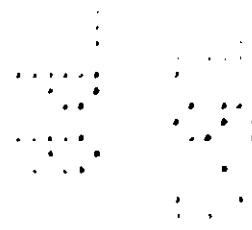
## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful or fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breath vapors. ## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

EXXCIDE 2000-S is Ready-to-Use. **DO NOT DILUTE, MIX WITH OTHER CHEMICALS OR SPRAY OR ATOMIZE THIS PRODUCT.**

Apply the recommended amount with a paint brush or paint roller. A watering can may also be used. **DO NOT USE A PAINT GUN OR SPRAY BOTTLE TO APPLY THIS PRODUCT.**

The recommended application rates are as follows:

Stucco Surfaces: Up to 150 ml(g)/m<sup>2</sup>, or approximately 0.5 oz/ft<sup>2</sup>.

Concrete and asphalt: 40 ml(g)/m<sup>2</sup>, or approximately 0.13 oz/ft<sup>2</sup>.

Wood Singles and Siding: 60 ml(g)/m<sup>2</sup>, or approximately 0.2 oz/ft<sup>2</sup>.

EXXCIDE 2000-S will provide control for 10-12 months.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Do not store this product with oxidizers, acids, reducing agents, or combustible materials. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated location away from direct sunlight. Protect from freezing. Store upright and do not stack over two drums per pallet. A drum pump is recommended for transferring this material. Keep drums tightly closed when not in use. Store only in the original containers or approved storage containers and guard against cross-contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Do not reuse containers.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
