IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

PURPOSE: FLEAGO is a flea killing powder. It is a dry crystal powder that works on the carpet and under the cushions of upholstered furniture to kill fleas.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Unscrew cap and remove sealer. Replace cap securely.

CARPETS:

- Apply to dry carpet only.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas in your home.
- By shaking container from side to side lightly sprinkle FLEAGO evenly over entire carpeted areas including under beds and furniture where carpet can be seen.

Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed.

• Please wait at least 5 days and vacuum treated areas.

UPHOLSTERY:

- Remove loose cushions. Apply along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply product on top of cushions.

• Any product visible after application should be removed.

REMEMBER: FLEAGO requires approximately 2-4 weeks to kill all fleas.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Do not eat pets with the product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals. CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. DO NOT USE on smooth hard surface floors. Crystal powder may make it slippery.

NOT AD:

ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Wash skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

DISPOSAL STATEMENT: If empty - Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partially full - Call your local solid waste agency, or 1-800-CLEANUP, which is managed as a public-private partnership.
