

For use in Greenhouses on Ornamental Plants and Field Grown Flowering Plants to control the following soft bodied insects: Aphids, Mealybugs, Whiteflies, Mites (family Tetranychidae, two spotted, brown, European red), exposed Western Flower and Greenhouse Thrips, Psyllids and Scale Crawlers.

## AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 4 CFR, part 170. Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval(REI) of 12 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water is:

Use of coveralls, waterproof gloves, shoes plus socks. Notify workers of the application by warning them orally and by posting warning signs at entrances to treated areas.

#### RATE OF APPLICATION:

-Use 2.5 pounds in 100 gallons of water depending upon desired viscosity.

-For whitefly infestation 5 pounds of product per 100 gallons of water(for light to average infestations) and 6.36 pounds product per 100 gallons of water for heavy infestations, or where poinsettia whitefly or other species difficult to control are present.

Flowers and Bedding Plants: Asters, begonia bouardia, cineraria, chrysanthemum, cyclamen, delphinium, dianthus, gardenia, gerbera daisy, gypsophila, ivy, lily, limonium, orchids, rose, salvia, snapdragons, and viola.

Ornamental Landscape Trees, Shrubs, and Foliage: acacia, bamboo, bird of paradise, camellia, crape myrtle, croton, escalonia, euonymus, ficus, hibiscus, kalanchos, lantana, ornamental pear, spathiphyllum, stephanotus, sycamore, and veronica.

#### APPLICATION:

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for Paddle and bypass agitation systems:

1. Fill the spray 1/3 full of water. NOTE: For cascade agitation system, paddles should be covered with water.
2. Activate agitation system.
3. Add the desired amount of CELL-U-WETT slowly to spray tank.
4. Complete filling tank while CELL-U-WETT is dispersing.
5. Before beginning to spray, make sure CELL-U-WETT has dispersed and dissolved. Note: 5 to 10 minutes to complete process.

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**TO USE SOLUTION:**

Spray plants to the dripping point at the recommended application rates. Make sure all plant surfaces are covered. Allow spray to dry completely.

Depending upon insect infestation, apply 1 to 2 times per week. For preventative measures, spray plants every 10 to 14 days.

The deposited film dries more rapidly in low humidity and high temperature. Its effectiveness is not influenced by temperature or humidity.

**CELL-U-WETT** is compatible with most commonly used insecticides and fungicides.
