Plato Industries' INSECTICIDE STRIP is for use only as a toxicant in insect traps, including those for cotton boll weevil, gypsy moth, spruce budworm, forest tent caterpillar, fruit flies, codling moth, southwestern corn borer, pepper weevil and sweet potato weevil. Do not use INSECTICIDE STRIP for any other purpose. For proper function of this product, insect traps should be designed to position the "vapor-releasing" strip in a confined insect trapping chamber where insects will be trapped in close vicinity to the strip's surface and vapors. Read directions for use accompanying the trap before opening the INSECTICIDE STRIP package. Replace strips every 2 - 5 weeks, depending on the insect species.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not open or remove from package before ready to use. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not reuse packaging or strips. Wrap and discard in trash.
