DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product may be used in homes, restaurants, and other food and food handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

Use Restrictions: Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets until application is complete. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants. Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. For all applications, visible product must be worked in or removed.

Application Directions:

FLEAS

CARPETS: Apply to dry surfaces only. Apply directly on carpets where pets frequently traffic or sleep at the rate of one pound per 100 square feet (31.5 mg/sq ft). Work powder deeply into fibers and mat. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or vacuumed. Allow powder to remain for a period of three to five weeks to achieve maximum flea control in carpets. Reapply as necessary.

Note: If high adult population makes it desirable, apply a pesticide designed to kill adult fleas before or in conjunction with this product.

Any powder visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed.
UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions. Apply with approved applicator along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply to exposed fabric. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks or crevices or removed. Reapply as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECT CONTROL

To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish, apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs, into openings around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells.

As a mop solution to control cockroaches mix and apply as follows. Add 1 cup of powder to each gallon of rinse water. Apply to floor areas only. Make only enough for each application. Supplemental treatment only.

Directions for Applying in New and Existing Construction to Control Cockroaches: When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction, dust liberally using dusting application equipment.

Directions for Applying in Sewers and Manhole Cavities: Apply this product at a rate not to exceed 12 oz. per 190 sq. ft. using portable blowers or air pressure tanks.

Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks or crevices or removed. Reapply as necessary.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Places other than private residences in which food or feed is held, processed, prepared, or served.

1 FOOD AREAS (INCLUDING SOME SERVING AREAS)

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils,

syrops). Also includes some SERVING AREAS.

SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, but not where food is prepared or held. These areas are considered **FOOD AREAS** when food is exposed and the facility is in operation.

Follow application directions in this section. If food is not exposed and facility is not in operation, follow application directions under **NONFOOD SERVING AREAS** below.

Use Restrictions: **FOOD AREA** application is limited to **CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY**. Applications to other areas are not permitted.

Application Directions: Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticides directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks or crevices or removed.

Reapply as necessary.

2 NONFOOD AREAS

(INCLUDING SOME SERVING AREAS)

Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Also includes some SERVING AREAS.

NONFOOD SERVING AREAS

SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, but not where food is prepared or held. These areas are considered **NONFOOD AREAS** when food is not exposed and the facility is not in operation.

Follow application directions in this section. If food is exposed and the facility is in operation, follow application directions under **FOOD SERVING AREAS**.

Application Directions: Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of constructions into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks or crevices or removed. Reapply as necessary.

OTHER NONFOOD AREAS

Application Directions: Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks or crevices or removed. Reapply as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

FOR 1, 5 AND 25 POUND CONTAINER SIZES: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

FOR 100 POUND CONTAINER SIZES: Completely empty liner by shaking and taping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

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
