The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

Proposed Amendment

- Revised label amendment

Labeling Comments

- 1) The First Aid Statement must be grouped in the same paragraph and read as follows:

**"First Aid"**

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

- 2) Based on net contents and use patter (household) of the subject product, the storage and disposal statement must be revised to read as follows:

**Pesticide Storage:** (TEXT)

**Container Disposal:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.


Note that product intended for household use need not include the heading "STORAGE AND HEADING." Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for further information.
