3. To mitigate any possible risks to aquatic organisms, we will require the following labeling changes, depending on the container size:

- a. For the 32 oz. size, which we assume is intended for **outdoor, domestic use only**, add the following "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" statement on the Back Panel as follows:

Within one year of registration, or **October 15, 1996**, you need to certify to us, in writing, that you have conducted efficacy studies conforming to the EPA Guidelines for conducting mole studies (96-8) and the Good Laboratory Practices (GLP) Regulations, 40 CFR 160, and that these studies verify the application directions accepted with this Notice of Registration.

Although you are not required to submit these data to the Agency for review and validation at the present time, you must maintain these studies in the event that the Agency needs to review them in the future, either as part of a review by the Registration Division or by enforcement personnel. If questions arise about the design or conduct of the study, please contact us.

If, by October 15, 1995, you have not 1) satisfied the requirement to certify that you have acceptable efficacy, or 2) have not provided us with an explanation of why you were unsuccessful in developing such data and with a request for an extension of time (indicating the amount needed) to gather additional data, the Agency will automatically cancel this registration, effective on that date.

- D. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

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This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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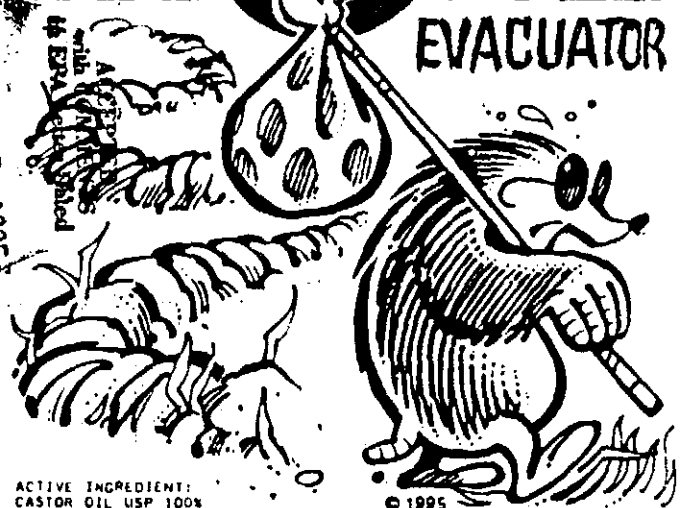

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product may be used to repel eastern moles (*Scalopus aquaticus*) from lawns, ornamental turf, golf courses, and athletic fields.

**LOCATING MOLES:** The presence of moles may be indicated by a network of surface ridges in the turf or by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from deep burrows. Treat all areas which show signs of moles' presence.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Shake container well before using product. Attach garden hose tightly to self-dispensing container. Turn water supply on to full pressure. Spray SCOOT MOLE EVACUATOR over mole-infested area at a rate of one quart of product per 3,000 sq. ft. (e.g., a 30-ft. by 100 ft. rectangle). Adjust the spray nozzle to "WATER". Continue to spray with water to soak SCOOT MOLE into the soil. Apply SCOOT MOLE immediately after the presence of moles is detected or in early Spring, mid-summer, and early Fall if there are moles nearby but not on your property.
