Product may also be used on bird feeders and flower gardens te-kelp deter feeding by squirrels. DO NOT SPRAY THIS PRODUCT ON FRUITS OR VEGETA-BLES OR ANY PRANT USED FOR HUMAN FOOD OR ANIMAL FEED. Because of the wide variety of plants and test conditions that may be encountered, test product for phytotoxic effects on small areas of plants to be treated before determining whether to treat entire plant or plantings.
