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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulations.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR, part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

For use in controlling Whitefly, Aphids, Thrips, Mealybugs and Leafhoppers in agricultural crops and forestry. Do not use with ultra low-volume application equipment.

DOSAGE RATE: Mix ¼ to one pound of MYCOTROL WP per acre with quantities of water sufficient to provide thorough coverage of infested plant parts, 30-100 gallons per acre and an approved spreader/sticker. (See Technical Data Sheet for mixing instructions and suitable spreaders.) Do not mix more MYCOTROL WP than can be used the day of application; MYCOTROL WP, if left overnight or longer in water, will lose its efficacy.

APPLICATION: Apply at 7-10 day intervals by conventional ground or commercial hand-held equipment. Under very intense pest pressure, apply at 3-5 day intervals. Repeat applications of MYCOTROL WP as many times as necessary while pest pressure persists. If rapid knockdown of heavy insect populations is necessary, include an effective contact insecticide, in combination with MYCOTROL WP. Refer to the product Technical Bulletins for compatible insecticides.

Do not tank mix with fungicides. There is no restriction as to the maximum amount of MYCOTROL WP applied in a season.

CHEMIGATION: Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

INSECTS FOR WHICH MYCOTROL WP MAY BE USED

WHITEFLY, SUCH AS: Banded-winged Whitefly, Citrus Blackfly, Citrus Whitefly, Greenhouse Whitefly, Silverleaf Whitefly, Sweet Potato Whitefly (aka Tobacco Whitefly).

APHIDS, SUCH AS: Bean Aphid, Cabbage Aphid, Cowpea Aphid, Green Peach Aphid, Greenbug, Hop Aphid, Melon/Cotton Aphid, Pea Aphid, Potato Aphid, Russian Wheat Aphid, Spotted Alfalfa Aphid.

THRIPS, SUCH AS: Greenhouse Thrips, Pear Thrips, Potato/Onion Thrips, *Thrips palmi*, Western Flower Thrips.
